OBJECTIVES

The 30-minute "Macao: Back to Common Roots Narrative Film" (Film) — a masterpiece that captures the essence of cultural tourism — vividly narrates the history and story of Macau. Screened at MGM Theater, it enables the audience to appreciate Macau's transformation over the past centuries via a multi-sensory experience entwining art and culture with history education. The Writing Competition is intended to further encourage local youth to learn more about Macau's history and reinforce their love for the Nation and Macau.

COMPETITION DETAILS

Eligibility:

Students in secondary schools and tertiary institutions in Macau

Category:

Junior Secondary School Group (Form 1-3); Senior Secondary School Group (Form 4-6); Tertiary Education Group Submission Deadline:
November 16, 2022 (Wednesday)

Writing Theme:

The Love for the Nation — Review for "Macao: Back to Common Roots Narrative Film". The entry should center around the writer's love for the Nation and Macau, and their boundless imaginations of the city's future, based on the content of the Film.

ENTRY FORMAT

- Topic & Language: Topic of your choice (written in Chinese).
- Word Count: Junior Secondary School Group: 800 words;

Senior Secondary School Group: 1000 words;

Tertiary Education Group: 1500 words (including punctuation marks)

- Layout: A4 Size; portrait orientation; horizontal writing (margins: 5cm Top; 2.5cm Bottom; 3.17cm for Right and Left)
- Font Format: PMingLiU or DFKai-SB (12pt font size; 1.5 line spacing; full-width punctuation)
- Document : Microsoft Word (PDF Format for submission)

SUBMISSION

- Entrant should submit the entry with the completed application form and ID Copy via email at penofmacau@gmail.com with the e-mail subject stating, "Application for 'Macao: Back to Common Roots Narrative Film' Writing Competition" by November 16, 2022 (Wednesday).
- Entries by the School Group are required to deliver in one compressed file.
- Entries can be submitted on behalf of a school or an individual. Submission by School Group is capped at 20 articles each, while this rule does not apply to submission by individuals.

Each Group has First-class, Second-class, and Third-class Awards; several Special Awards; as well as Group Award. Cash prizes, dining vouchers and certificates will be awarded to winners. The Group Award is judged based on the school's overall awards and writing quality.
