Objective	The 72 <sup>nd</sup> Macau Grand Prix, Macau's iconic international sporting event, will be held from November 13 to 16, 2025. Known for its innovation, the Grand Prix this year will once again bring fresh ideas to the races. Echoing this innovative spirit, MGM aims to integrate cultural and artistic elements into the annual sports spectacle, inviting Macao residents and visitors to experience the vibrant atmosphere of the Grand Prix.

Students and people with disabilities in Macao are invited to unleash their creativity and pay tribute to the 72 <sup>nd</sup> Macau Grand Prix through original helmet designs. Outstanding entries will be featured as photo spots in specific locations at the Macao Grand Prix Museum and showcased as part of a museum exhibition.
Theme	Encourage students to use art to express their passion for car racing, showcase their design talent, and pay tribute to the 72 <sup>nd</sup> Macau Grand Prix
Eligibility	Macao primary Grade 4 to senior high school Grade 12 students (with Macao SAR Permanent Resident Identity Card)
Participation guidelines	<ol> <li>Students may register individually or through their affiliated organization.</li> <li>A total of 90 spots are available and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis according to the order of registration.</li> <li>Participants must attend a helmet design session in person at the Macao Grand Prix Museum on October 26.</li> <li>The organizer will provide basic color pens and craft materials. Participants may also bring their own materials.</li> <li>The helmet dimensions are 20cm x 20cm; the material is plaster.</li> <li>All submissions must align with the event theme. Those that fail to do so will not be accepted.</li> <li>For submissions that feature the national flag or national emblem of the People's Republic of China, or the regional flag</li> </ol>

	or emblem of the Macau SAR, such symbols must be depicted accurately and in full.  8. Copyright:  a. All submissions must be original works. The use of any information or materials that infringe upon third-party intellectual rights is strictly prohibited.  b. If participants use any third-party materials, they must ensure they have obtained the necessary legal permissions and provide proper source attribution. Submissions that fail to meet these requirements will not be accepted.

Rewards and presentation	<ol> <li>All participants who join this campaign will receive a certificate of appreciation.</li> <li>The certificates will be distributed on-site once participants have completed their work.</li> <li>Participants whose works are selected for display in the Macao Grand Prix Museum will each receive a MOP 200 MGM dining voucher.</li> <li>The dining vouchers will be presented to selected participants during the exhibition opening ceremony (date to be confirmed). Late collection will be considered a forfeiture of the vouchers, and no re-issuance will be provided.</li> <li>The organizer reserves the right to make the final decision on the number of participants and selected entries.</li> </ol>
